Background Ferrari World is the first Ferrari themed amusement park in the world, located on Yas Island, Abu Dhabi. It includes four theme parks, two water parks, 23 on-site themed resort hotels including a campsite, two spas and physical fitness centers, five golf courses, and other recreational venues. The central park is situated under a 200,000 square meters roof making it the largest indoor amusement park in the world. It was completed in 2010 with a project value of 1 billion US\$. Scope

The iconic design of Ferrari World was developed by Benoy Architects. It is modeled on the side profile of a Ferrari GT by Ramboll. The project has set benchmarks for structural engineering, master planning and urban design, geotechnical engineering and facade engineering in the region.
